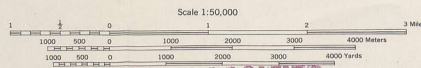

THE LAST THREE DIGITS OF THE GRID NUMBERS ARE OMITTED



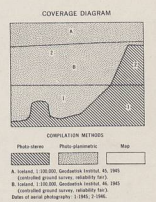
